

Coins Game

Using a simple 'Squares Board', a dice, and some counters (coins, buttons or similar), you can play a game to help children learn counting and one-to-one correspondence.



How to Play?

- ☺ Have a board for each player and some counters in the middle for sharing.
- ☺ Throw the dice and for the number shown place counters on the board.
- ☺ The person to fill their card first is the winner.

Play in reverse order to learn about subtraction

- ☺ Start with a full card.
- ☺ Throw the dice and take away the corresponding number of counters.
- ☺ The person to empty their card first is the winner.

Children will learn:

- ☺ One-to-one correspondence - one counter for each square.
- ☺ Counting 1 to 10 and beyond.
- ☺ Language for maths; numbers, full, empty, add, take-away, how many, more, less, order (first, second, etc).
